## There are six categories

### 1. Tenants' Group Award

Tenants' groups work hard to make their estates better places to live. If your local tenants' group has made a real impact on the neighbourhood, why not put them forward? Whether a group has been good at campaigning for improvements in the community, at organising events like community clean-ups, or brought the community together in some other way, please tell us. In addition to individual nominations, tenants' groups can nominate themselves.

### 2. Under 18 Young Person Award

This award is to highlight the efforts of young people who make a positive contribution to their communities by helping other people. Examples might be through playing a part in local community activities or helping individuals (such as elderly neighbours).

### 3. Making a Stand Award

This award is in recognition of those individuals who take the difficult step of speaking out against those who create problems on their estates and make the lives of others a misery through anti-social behaviour. You can nominate one person or a group of people for this award.

### 4. Turnaround Award

One of the biggest challenges for an individual is to face up to the fact that they need to change their own behaviour and become an asset to their communities. This award is aimed at people who have started to turn their own lives around.

### 5. Community Contribution Award

This award is aimed at individuals or groups who have contributed to strengthening the community. Examples would be people who give their time to the community through volunteering, coaching or just by being a good neighbour. These do not need to be Pennine Housing tenants, just as long as what they do brings benefits to the local neighbourhood. It may be someone like a Police Community Support Officer, a Youth Worker or someone who is active in the community.

### 6. Pennine Housing 'Outstanding Member of Staff' Award

This award recognises that Pennine Housing staff can 'and do' make a big difference to the communities they work in. It is aimed at staff members who put in that extra effort, whether it be through initiatives they have come up with or community activities which they have supported.
